

# Cable Queen - 1511

**FILS:** 2 skeins of Fine Merino Superwash DK of Diamond Luxury color 1090 (50g. = 125m)

**MATÉRIEL:** 4 mm DPN or circular needle if you would like to use the Magic Loop  
Cable needle  
Marker  
Yarn tapestry needle

**ÉCHANTILLON:** 22 stitches by 28 rows = 10 cm in stockinette

**SIZE:** One size. Head circumference between 52 cm to 68 cm.

## Glossary terms:

k ○○○○○○○○○ knit  
p ○○○○○○○○○ purl  
C6F ○○○○○○○ cable 6 front  
C6B ○○○○○○○ cable 6 back  
k2tog ○○○○○○○ knit 2 together



## Stitches used and Tips&Tricks:

### Cable 6 Front (C6F)

Slip next 3 sts on your cable needle and leave in front of your work, k3 and then k3 from your cable needle.

### Cable 6 Back (C6B)

Slip next 3 stitches on your cable needle and leave in the back of your work, k3 and then k3 from your cable needle.

### Provisional Cast-On

With a different yarn, cast on your stitches and then start to knit with the yarn used for your project.  
At the end of the project, carefully pull the cast on and use the live stitches as the pattern calls for.

## Band of the beret

With your 4 mm straight needle or dpn cast-on 26 stitches using your favorite provisional cast-on. You will work back in forth for this part.

Row 1: k24, p2  
Row 2 : k2, p24  
Row 3 : \*C6F\* Repeat from \* to \* 4 times in total, p2  
Row 4 : k2, p24  
Row 5 : k24, p2  
Row 6 : k2, p24  
Row 7: K3, \*C6B \* repeat from \* to \* 3 times, K3, P2  
Row 8 : k2, p24

Repeat those 8 rows until the band measures 50 cm long and ending with row 8. Undo the provisional cast on 3 stitches at a time and with the Kitchener stitch sew both ends together.

## Béret

With your 4 mm dpn pick up 168 stitches on the side where you can see your 2 purls. Place a stitch marker to know the beginning of your round.

Knitting in the round until the end.

Round 1, 3, 4, 5, 7 and 8 : K all  
Round 2 : k96, \*C6F\* repeat from \* to \* 4 times in total, k48  
Round 6 : k99, \*C6B\* repeat from \* to \* 3 times in total, k51

Repeat those 8 rounds 4 times in total.

## Decrease rounds:

Round 1 : \*k12, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the round (156 stitches)  
Round 2,6, 8, 11, 16 and 18 : K all  
Round 3 : \*k11, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the round (144 stitches)  
Round 4 : k86, \*C6F\* repeat from \* to \* 3 times in total, k40.  
Round 5 : \*k10, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the round (132 stitches)  
Round 7 : \*k9, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the round (120 stitches)  
Round 9 : \*k8, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the round (108 stitches)  
Round 10 : k65, \*C6B\* repeat from \* from \* twice in total, k31  
Round 12 : \*k7, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the round (96 stitches)  
Round 13 : \*C6F\* repeat from \* to \* 16 times in total  
Round 14 : k2tog, k all the rest of the stitches(95 stitches)  
Round 15 : \*k3, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the round (76 stitches)  
Round 17 : \*k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the round (38 stitches)  
Round 19 : \*k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* until the end of the round (19 stitches)

Cut yarn and pull the end through the remaining stitches. Pull to close the hat and wave in ends.
